The Southwest Nebraska RC&D Council has recently adopted the Republican River Riparian Project. Under this project the council is proposing to develop partnerships to inventory the riparian area of the river and its tributaries and find ways to utilize these areas to their potential.

The first step the council is planning to take is to sponsor a meeting to determine what is presently available, what is needed to complete the inventory and develop a course of action to complete the effort.

The Council is requesting agencies and organizations to share data, reports and information they have on the Republican River, work they are participating in and future work they are planning. - 11:30 – Determine what objectives landowners along the river may be interested in and what can your agency offer to help accomplish these objectives.
- 12:15 – Summarize and adjourn.
