PERIODIC REPORT – OCTOBER 1, 2005 TO DECEMBER 31, 2005 – Project 05-161 Nebraska Augmentation Program for Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program Efforts

The purpose of this project is to administer a major project that will help reduce the quantity of water being used in selected areas of the Platte and Republican River Basins in Nebraska while providing additional conservation/environmental benefits. A number of Nebraska Department of Natural Resources staff have been contributing extensively to early administration of the state funding commitment. One staff member has been redirected specifically to administer program efforts. Salary and benefits for the hours that staff member specifically spent on CREP administration during the October 1 to December 31 time period came to \$7,557.24 and are being charged to the Trust with the billing that accompanies this report. That brings the total billings for all months under the Trust grant to \$21,904.82. Salary and benefits for hours other staff members spent on CREP activities are valued at \$30,880.59 and are being reported as match. The hours and hourly rates per employee for matching amounts are not included in this report but can be provided upon request. The hours and hourly rates for the employee whose expenses are being billed to the Trust are included along with detailed timesheet information for that employee.

REQUEST FOR REIMBURSEMENT

We are requesting reimbursement in the amount of \$7,557.24 for expenses incurred in the period of October 1, 2005 to December 31, 2005 on the Nebraska Augmentation Program for USDA Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program Efforts. We have provided accompanying documentation of expenses.
