Dear Mary,

This letter is to inform you that due to cost savings our expenditures on Environmental Trust Project Number 03-164-LB 1003 Water Policy Study / Project will be at least \$200,000 below the \$350,000 amount of the grant award. We therefore ask that the \$200,000 be released by the Trust for use on other purposes. As was done with Project 00135-3, Tri-Basin NRD Platte River Valley Irrigation Well Census, we request that the released funds be made available for cost share on water meters in Nebraska's Republican River Basin. Installation of these meters is critical to successful implementation of the Republican River Settlement.

The cost savings of this project have come from a number of sources. These include: 1) the facilitators hired for the project have expended less than anticipated, 2) staff and task force members were able to supply legal and technical information than was originally anticipated to require costly contract work, and 3) many of the groups to which task force members belong were able to provide travel expenses. We currently anticipate the Task Force will complete its original charge on schedule and considerably under budget. We greatly appreciate the support of the Trust on this project.
