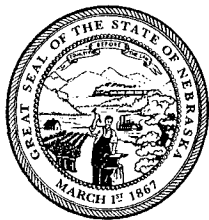

61-208. Department of Natural Resources; powers; surveys of streams. The Department of Natural Resources may make surveys of streams showing the location of possible water power developments and irrigation projects; identify and map tracts of land to be served with water for irrigation or other beneficial purposes and points of diversion; ~~and identify and map tracts of land involved in water rights transfers.~~ Employees of the Department of Natural Resources shall not be required to be licensed as a Registered Land Surveyor under Sections 81-8,108 through 81-8,127 or comply with the provisions of such Sections in the performance of their duties under this Section.
