Dave,

I went through the list of senior permits (Senior to April 3, 1946) that I sent Justing and came up with 10 permits that could divert. If all diverted at the same time 5.18 cfs would be diverted, that would equal 10.27 AF/ day.

If they pump 2/3 of the time over 90 days they would have pumped about 600 AF.

Not all of these people will pump!
