- They are close to being finished with digitizing based on 2003 photos

FSA digitizes every year, & can get a number each year that is different. The URNBD is working to track certified acres, but will make changes on a rare basis.

Jasper believes it is about accuracy - irrigated acres not reported (satellite) - certified acres that are not irrigated

Satellite acre - a certified irrigated acre that does not receive an allocation

Certification of acres began in 1978. Wells were drilled through the 1980s, and to some extent, into the 1990s.

SHAPE FILE

- We asked for certified acres for:
- 1) For general knowledge re: NE pumping
 - 2) Recharge in the GW model

2002-3 they stopped allowing new (satellite) acres - still allow transfers etc.

Talked about "level of development" -> refers to river depletions. W.L. are the wells on N-Fork / Main Stem dropping not in the area where the transfer is coming from
