APPROVAL OF APPLICATION

(This is not a permit or certificate of appropriation)

This is to certify that I have examined application No. 5030 of the applicant _____

Jacob Glenn Dick

Rural Route #2, Sedgwick, Kansas

for a permit or certificate to appropriate water to beneficial use, together with the maps, plans and other submitted data, and that the same are hereby approved and he is hereby authorized to proceed with steps required to perfect his proposed appropriation subject to the following terms, conditions and limitations:

1. The priority date assigned to such application is January 19, 1956
2. The water sought to be appropriated shall be used for irrigation purposes.
3. The source of the water appropriation sought shall be from wells located in the drainage basin of the Arkansas River in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, Township 25 South, Range 1 West in Sedgwick County, Kansas.
4. The appropriation sought shall be limited to being diverted at a rate not in excess of 1,000 gallons per minute (2.23 cubic feet per second) and to a quantity of not to exceed 120 acre feet for any calendar year.
5. The application of water for the purpose sought shall be actually made on or before December 31, 19 58, or within any authorized extension of time.
6. The applicant shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources when he has completed construction of necessary works and has actually applied water to the proposed use. Such notice shall be filed not later than ten days after the date specified in paragraph 5 above or any authorized extension thereof. Failure to file the required notice within the time allowed will result in forfeiture of priority of the application.
7. The applicant shall not be deemed to have acquired a water appropriation for a quantity in excess of the amount approved herein nor in excess of the amount found by the Chief Engineer to have been actually used for the approved purpose during one calendar year within the time limits specified or any authorized extension thereof.
8. The superior rights of persons using water for domestic use must be respected.

9. The prior rights of persons who, by compliance with the Laws of the State of Kansas, have acquired and retained a right to the use of the water from this source must not be unlawfully interfered with by the initiation of the use sought by the applicant.

10. The approval of this application shall not be deemed any assurance that a sufficient supply of unappropriated water is now or will always be available.
